# Admire It

## Ravenna outdoors

Guided itineraries that will take you on a pleasant walk along the main streets of the historic center of Ravenna to discover the most evocative and lesser-known corners, famous people, anecdotes and legends, food and wine and street art. A guided tour in the historic center, to deepen the rich heritage of the city, churches and basilicas, of which the 8 Unesco monuments are the flagship.

## Dante tells; a tour between art and nature

A journey full of symbols to discover the mosaics of the Byzantine basilica of San Apollinare in Classe that describe the ancient wood, praised by Dante in the Divine Comedy

A temporal passage in the "thick and lively forest" of the Classe pine forest, one of the most important examples extended of extremely variegated plain wood. It was the subject of the description of the Earthly Paradise, in the second canticle of the Divine Comedy, by the poet Dante Alighieri, the scene of amorous encounters praised by Boccaccio and of war events during the second world war.

## Street Dante

Through a walk in the center you will visit the works of street art, Dante's tomb, the basilica of San Francesco, the quadrarcho of the strongarm and the Franciscan cloisters.

All interspersed with various literary moments.

## Ravenna Noir

### The lesser known face of the city of mosaics

When darkness falls we will leave from Dante's Tomb, for a walking tour of the most evocative places of the city, to discover its dark side and the mysteries hidden behind the splendor of its mosaics.

Stories of martyrs, heinous murders for political purposes wanted or perpetrated by King Theodoric, the history of the 'Society of Stabblers' and unsolved thrillers like that of Anita and the mysterious legend that surrounds the figure of the Passatore.

Lastly, the murder of Paolo and Francesca that Dante Alighieri - who died in Ravenna in 1321 - immortalized in his Comedy.



# Admire It

## **Guided tour** **Byzantine Ravenna**

During this 3-hour tour you will have the opportunity to visit, looked after by our expert guide, three wonders, jewel of our city: the Basilica of San Vitale, one of the most important monuments of early Christian art in Italy, the Basilica of Sant' Apollinare Nuovo, originally used as a Palatine Church of Arian worship, today allows us to reconstruct the evolution of the Byzantine mosaic and the Chapel of Sant'Andrea, the only example of an early Christian archbishop's chapel still intact today.

## **Brisighella history and flavors**

Visit one of the most beautiful villages in Italy, Brisighella! Walk through its alleys and taste the typical products of the area! Immerse yourself in the history of the village and discover the panorama of the Lamone Valley and all the alleys of this charming village, every corner hides a surprise!

Before your eyes, the roofs of the ancient houses of the village and an exceptional view of the gullies that surround the village. Your experience does not end there! Reach a fantastic panoramic terrace, a tasting of excellent local products awaits you, such as typical cheese, Brisighella D.O.P. and cured meats from Mora Romagnola, an ancient pig breed that you can only find here!



# Admire It

## Cervia

### The city of white gold

A guided tour that will tell us the history of Cervia: of its strong link with the sea and the Etruscan salt pans to which it owes the name of "Città dell'Oro Bianco". We will visit Piazza Garibaldi, the cathedral with its spire bell tower, the imposing Palazzo del Municipio, the Tower of San Michele built at the end of the 17th century, for the defense of the port and the precious salt warehouse up to the MUSA, the salt museum.

## City tour

### The painted houses of Dozza

Discover the village of Dozza, a small place considered one of the most characteristic medieval villages in Italy. Immersed in silence, walk through its alleys, between the painted walls of the houses ...

Each facade has its own work of art. This evocative open-air art gallery is the protagonist of the Painted Wall Biennale, an event that gathers many visitors every year. The city tour takes you to discover the entire history of Dozza, up to the fascinating Rocca Sforzesca, located on the top of the village!

Just outside the town, a rich tasting session based on typical local products awaits you, do not miss the opportunity: taste the best of local food and wine.

## Ravenna Ghost Tour

Ravenna city famous throughout the world for its mosaics and rich history, but sometimes the light gives way to the darkness of certain alleys in the center where secrets and tales of strange presences lurk.

It seems that even the "Supreme Poet" still roams certain alleys and in some buildings.

Just as the Sun begins to 'backtrack,' we will take you along a city itinerary to discover the stories of some ghosts and intriguing, often unknown characters that populate the collective imagination.

### City tour

## The painted houses of Dozza

In Ravenna, there is an art that seems eternal, that of early Christian mosaics, and an art that is rapidly aging instead... Close to the Canale Candiano, a reminder of the inseparable link between the Byzantine city and the sea, since 2011 the ruined walls of old abandoned factories have begun to become the palettes of street artists, the likes of Ericailcane. Since 2014, the 'Subsidenze' festival has been attracting various internationally renowned artists to Ravenna who, though often laboriously, have managed to infect and color the neighborhood. The citadel of street art, on the occasion of the 700th anniversary of Dante Alighieri's death, has been enriched with a number of themed murals, all to be discovered and interpreted.

# Drinking

## Bertinoro wines in paradise

This winery has written some of the most beautiful pages in the history of Italian wine. From its panoramic terrace, admire the landscape that stretches as far as the Adriatic Sea. Explore the ancient Lovatelli park surrounding the property where 40 peacocks roam freely and stop at this enchanting spot for a charming dinner. Visit the three museums inside: the Wine Museum, which houses one of Italy's finest collections of historic bottles, the Museum of Rural Life and the Vintage Car and Motorcycle Museum.

A rich tasting of typical local products awaits you, accompanied by four different wines, extra virgin olive oil and their own balsamic sauce.

## Modigliana the ancient vineyard

We will take you on a visit to the ancient Sangiovese vineyard cultivated with the alberello system, discovered by chance around the year 2000, perhaps the oldest in Italy, dating back to 1922!

Take a trip back in time by visiting the ancient vineyard and then the monastery complex dating back to 1561, which is now the company headquarters.

Taste 5 wines and the Bio Dop Brisighella extra virgin olive oil accompanied by local cold cuts and cheeses.

## Wine at the Courtyard

A journey through time to the origins of music. Start by visiting the masterpiece of Romanesque art dating back to the 6th century, Pomposa Abbey! Immerse yourself in the history of this ancient place that hosted Guido da Pomposa, the inventor of modern musical transcription. Treat yourself to a tasting of food and wine excellence, in the heart of the Po Delta Regional Park. Visit the cellar of the historic winery that has been producing wines known as "Vini delle Sabbie" from its own vineyards for 60 years. Surrender to the unique flavour of their grapes.

## A Family Wine

Wine is a tradition and a passion that binds this family inextricably to the land, it is an important part of the rural tradition of Romagna and serving it on the table means sharing with guests the love and pride for the fruit of the earth's work. In the town of hospitality, Bertinoro, you will be welcomed to this family-run farm, where the "Sun Vineyard" will open up a wonderful panorama of peace and knowledge ...

Then, a visit to the winery, where you will be explained the secrets of this uniquely flavoured wine and finally we will move on to the most fun and tasty part, wine tastings combined with a selection of local artisan products typical of the area.

# Walking

## The flooded forest of Punta Alberete and Pinewood of San Vitale

Walk through flooded forests, brackish lagoons and monumental pines, observe the numerous specimens of birds that, after thousands of kilometers in flight, choose these fabulous places to nest and raise their young.

## Sunset in the valleys of Comacchio

Wrapped in the warm colors of the sunset, live an experience to remember.

Immerse yourself in history and learn about the main activities on which the city of Comacchio was once based: fishing and salt production.

With binoculars you will admire unique landscapes and moments of life of the animals that live in this area. In fact, it will be possible to observe birds hatching, courtship, the care of the young and the nest defense techniques.

## **In search of the Deer of the Dunes in the Mesola forest**

Feel like nature? Want to walk, want to savor time, slowly? Let's enter a corner of paradise: the Boscoforte peninsula in the heart of the Comacchio valleys. An area that has preserved, thanks to a work of protection and closure to the public, a very rich biodiversity.

Let's discover in this ancient dune cordon the Camargue-Delta horses, which have been roaming wild for many years now.

A world suspended between sky, earth and water, which hosts for nesting several species of birds including the famous pink flamingo, a spectacle for young and old alike.

Accompanied by an expert guide, you will start from the first hills of Forlì, where Dante lived during his exile, until you reach Ravenna, where his body rests. The first day you leave Forlì in the direction of Terra del Sole, Castrocaro, Polenta and Bertinoro "The Balcony of Romagna". After a well-deserved rest, we will go down to Ravenna, the city that still preserves Dante's tomb.

Take a trip to the ancient underwater cliffs through the Spungone walking trail.

A full immersion in the beauty of an ancient city that over the millennia has never ceased to be creative and strongly connected to its territory and the rest of the world.

### Day 1:

Arrival at the farmhouse, free afternoon, relaxation and dinner at the farmhouse

### Day 2:

Welcome to the agriturismo. Guided visit to the MIC (International Museum of Ceramics). Demonstration of the 'sfoglina' and dinner with Cesarina who will delight you with her recipes.

### Day 3:
